The Appointing Authority/Fellowship Awarding Authority must verify the original documents/certificates including the percentage score or the equivalent in case of other grading system and the recognition of the University/Instt. of the candidate as well as eligibility criteria and SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/PwD status (wherever applicable) while considering him/her for appointment/awarding fellowship, as CSIR-HRDG is not responsible for the same.
- 2.a Essential educational qualifications: (M.Sc. or equivalent degree/Integrated BS-MS/BS 4 yrs./B.E/B.Tech/B.Pharm/MBBS with at least 55% marks (without rounding off) for General(UR)/General-EWS and OBC candidates and 50% marks (without rounding off) for SC/ST and PwD candidates.
Candidates enrolled for M.Sc. or having completed 10+2+3 of the above qualifying examinations as on the closing date of submission of online application form i.e. 02.01.2022 are also eligible to apply under the Result Awaited (RA) category) on the condition that they complete the qualifying degree with the requisite percentage of marks within the validity period of two years to avail the fellowship. Such candidate will have to submit the attestation form duly certified by the Head of the Department of the Institute from where the candidate is appearing or has appeared.
B.Sc. (Hons.) or equivalent degree holders or students enrolled in integrated MS-Ph.D. program with at least 55% marks (without rounding off) for General (UR)/General-EWS and OBC candidates and 50% marks (without rounding off) for SC/ST and PwD candidates are also eligible to apply. Candidates with Bachelor's degree will be eligible for CSIR fellowship only after getting registered/enrolled for Ph.D./Integrated Ph.D. program within the validity period of two years.
Candidates possessing only Bachelor's degree are eligible to apply only for Junior Research Fellowship and not for Lectureship/Assistant Professor.
Specification of degrees (whether bachelor or Master) as notified by UGC in its Gazette Notification No. F.5-1/2013(CPP-II) dated 5th July 2014 and as amended from time to time, shall apply.
The eligibility for Lectureship/Assistant Professor of NET qualified candidates will be subject to fulfilling the criteria laid down by UGC. Ph.D. degree holders who had passed Master's degree prior to 19th September 1991 with at least 50% marks (without rounding off) are eligible to apply for Lectureship/Assistant Professor only.
- 2.b Upper Age Limit & Relaxation:
Junior Research Fellowship (JRF): 28 years as on 01.07.2020 (relaxation up-to 5 years for SC/ST/PwD/Women candidates and up-to 3 years for OBC-Non Creamy layer (Central List) candidates.)
Lectureship (LS)/Assistant Professor: No upper age limit.
3. SC/ST/OBC/PwD/EWS certificates should be as per Govt instructions and in the prescribed format.

The universities, institutions, IITs and other national organizations may select the JRF awardees for full time research work in accordance with the procedure prescribed by them.

Economically Weaker Section (EWS), Scheduled Caste(SC)/Scheduled Tribe(ST)/Persons with Disability(PwD)/ Thirdgender /Other Backward Classes -Non creamy layer (OBC-NCL), as per the central list of Other Backward Classes available on National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC), Government of India website: www.ncbc.nic.in, candidate will be given such special concessions as may be decided by the UGC.
8. Candidates qualifying for the award of Junior Research fellowship will be eligible to receive fellowship of UGC under various schemes, subject to their finding placement in universities/IITs/institutions. The validity period of the offer is three years w.e.f. the date of issue of JRF Award Letter. However, in case the candidates who have already joined M. Phil / Ph.D., the date of commencement of fellowship shall be from the date of declaration of NET result or date of their joining, whichever is later.
