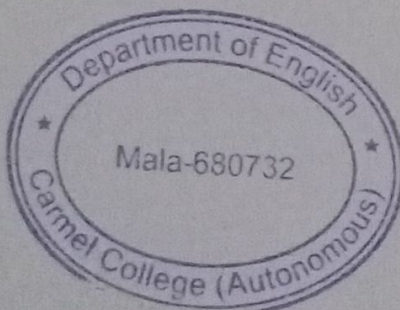
SPOTLIGHT 2K22: TALENT HUNT (26-09-2022)

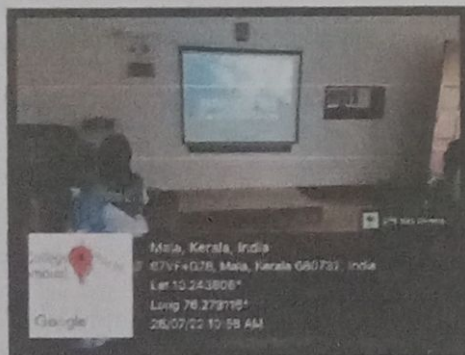
Screening of the Documentary: *Kargil Vijay Diwas*

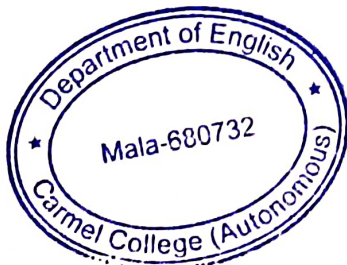
**Seminar on “Women Characters in Malayalam New Generation Films”,

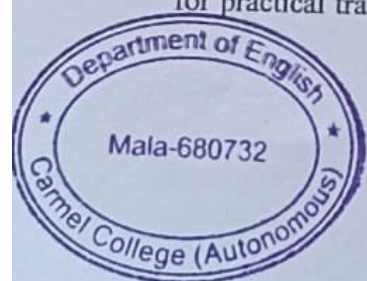
THE SIGNIFICANCE OF LANGUAGE LAB IN THE TEACHING OF ENGLISH (02-06-22)


language skills of the learners. They are exposed to functional language in use and are familiarized with the many pronunciation styles that are vital in everyday usage of the English language in today's world.

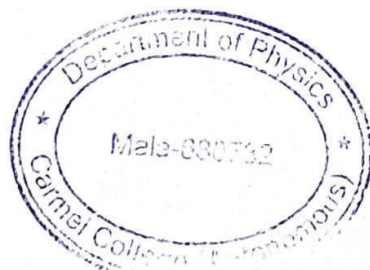
Report - Christmas Star Expo

Students received hands-on experience in making the stars and with the sale they received a small income.



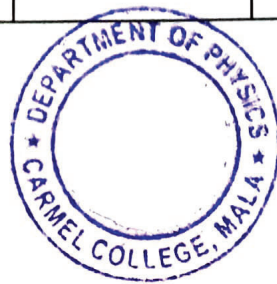
