Report

On 07-07-2023, the Department of Agriculture organized a seminar focussed on the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) Licensing process. The webinar aimed to educate participants of acquiring FSSAI Licenses, and to address any queries they might have had regarding the licensing procedure. This report summarizes the key highlights and outcomes of the webinar

The primary aim of the webinar was to create awareness among the participants, Primarily B. Voc. Agricultural students, about the process and importance of getting an FSSAI License. Outcome:




played a crucial role in enhancing the participants understanding and confidence in navigating the licensing process effectively.










Organizing A seminar on the topic

Beat Plastic Pollution in the Plastic Planet 05.06.2023

In observance of World Environment Day 2023, the Department of Botany, in collaboration with the Eco-friendly & Ethnobotany Club and IQAC, organized a seminar on the crucial topic, "Beat Plastic Pollution in the Plastic Planet." The event took place on June 5, 2023, at 2:00 pm in the College Auditorium. Ms. R Lakshmi, assistant conservator of forest, DFO Vazhachal was the resource person. The seminar commenced with a solemn prayer. Dr. Geo Joseph, the Coordinator of the seminar, delivered a warm welcome address, expressing gratitude to the participants and setting the stage for the impactful discussions to follow. Dr. Sr. Kochuthressia KP, the Principal-in-charge, delivered the presidential address, emphasizing the importance of addressing plastic pollution for the well-being of our environment. Dr. Bindhu KB, Head of the Department of Botany, delivered words of felicitation, highlighting the department's commitment to environmental awareness and sustainable practices. The seminar session was really interactive and interesting. Resource person shared her experience and it really motivated us.

Ms. R Lakshmi, Assistant Conservator of Forest, DFO Vazhachal, began the session with an insightful introduction to the theme, "Beat the Plastic Pollution." She elaborated on the adverse effects of plastic, including global warming and the dangers of microplastics. The presentation included alarming facts, such as the projected increase in the plastic content of oceans surpassing living content by 2030. Ms. R Lakshmi captivated the audience by sharing her personal experiences during the floods in Kerala, emphasizing the urgency of environmental protection. The resource person conveyed that World Environment Day is not merely a

celebration but a reminder of our collective responsibility to protect nature for future generations. Similarly, the Eastern Himalayas are home to numerous endemic species due to the unique combination of altitude and climate.

Saudi Arabia, on the other hand, has a predominantly arid climate with vast deserts such as the Rub' al Khali (Empty Quarter). Despite the challenging conditions, Saudi Arabia still harbours several endemic plant species that have adapted to survive in these extreme environments. The Arabian Peninsula's unique geography, including mountains, wadis (dry riverbeds), and coastal areas, also contributes to the presence of distinct plant species.






Outcome: The seminar puts a spotlight on the pressing environmental challenges of our times and called for a concerted global effort to repair the damage that has been done.
