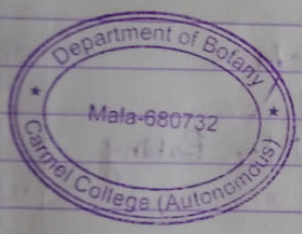

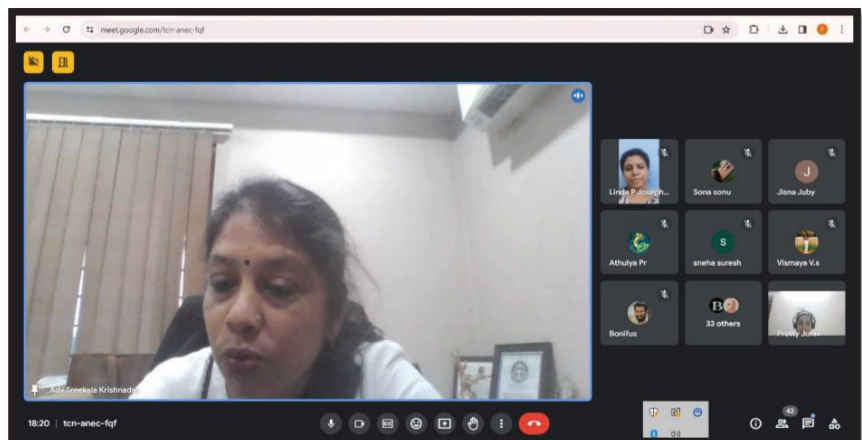
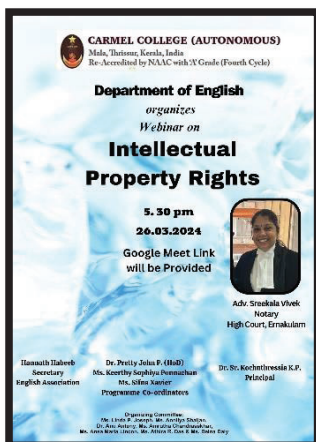

Professional Development: The webinar provided valuable insights into the practical application of intellectual property laws in various professional contexts, enhancing participants' professional skills and competencies.

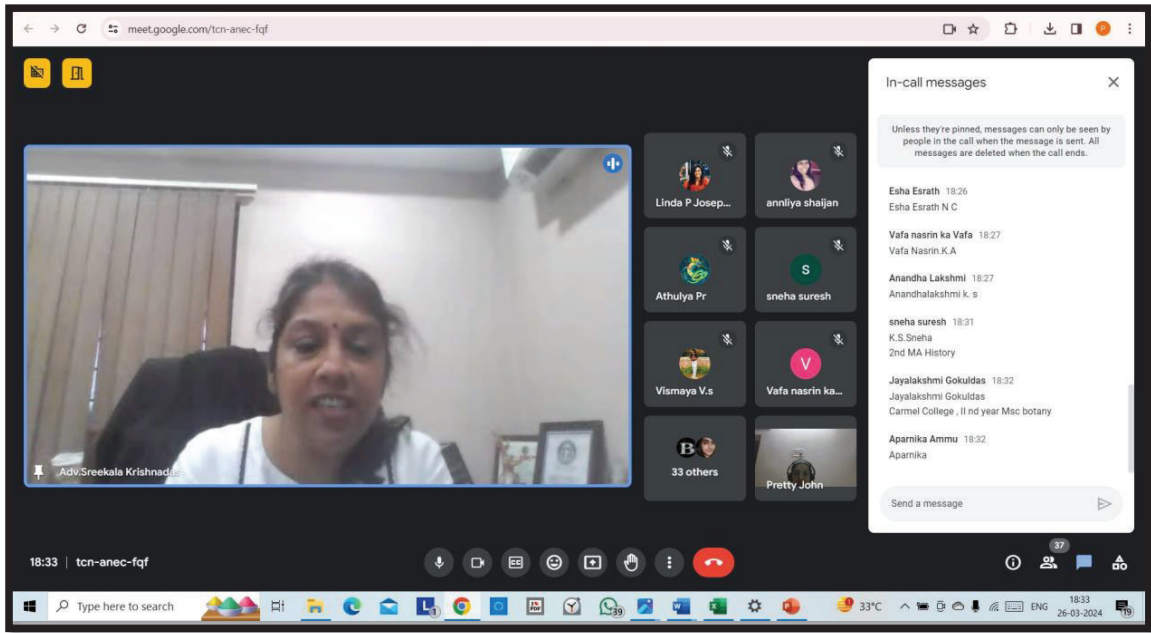
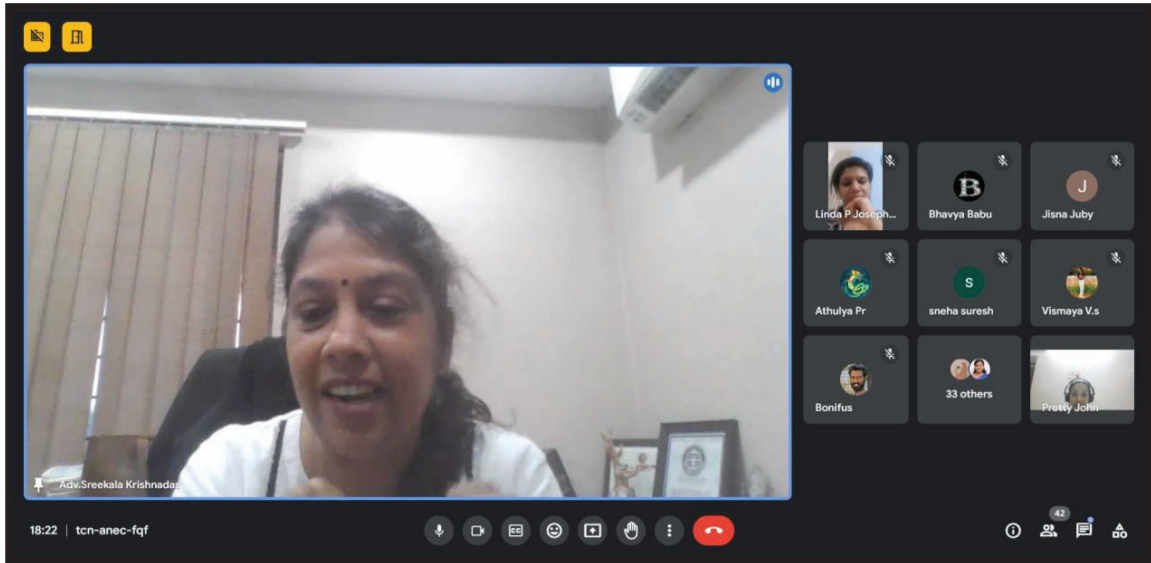

Understanding Cyber Threats: The participants gained insights into the evolving landscape of cyber security.

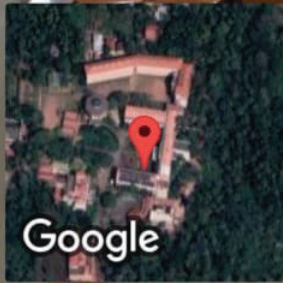
