The workshop covered a wide range of topics, including:

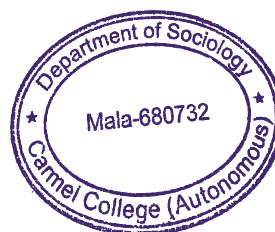

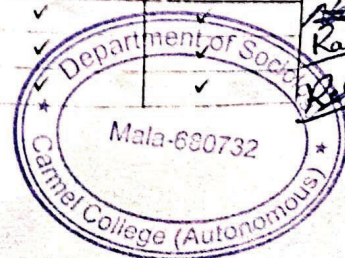

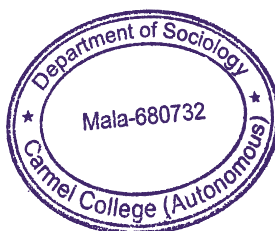
Panel Discussion consisted of multiple sessions covering different aspects of research methodology:

Participants actively participated in discussions, sharing their challenges and experiences with incorporating E-Resources into their academic pursuits. Dr. Jesmi P J provided personalized guidance, addressing specific concerns and offering tips on optimizing electronic resources for botany research. 25 participants actively engaged in the programme.

Outcome: Attendees gained insights into advanced search strategies and techniques, enhancing their ability to find relevant botanical information swiftly. Participants became familiar with a broader spectrum of electronic resources specific to botany, diversifying their research avenues beyond traditional sources. The workshop facilitated networking among botany scholars, creating opportunities for interdisciplinary collaborations and knowledge exchange. Participants left the workshop with a heightened sense of confidence and proficiency in navigating E-Resources, positioning them as informed and tech-savvy contributors to the academic community.

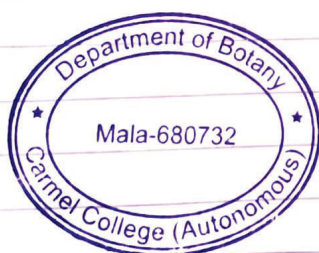



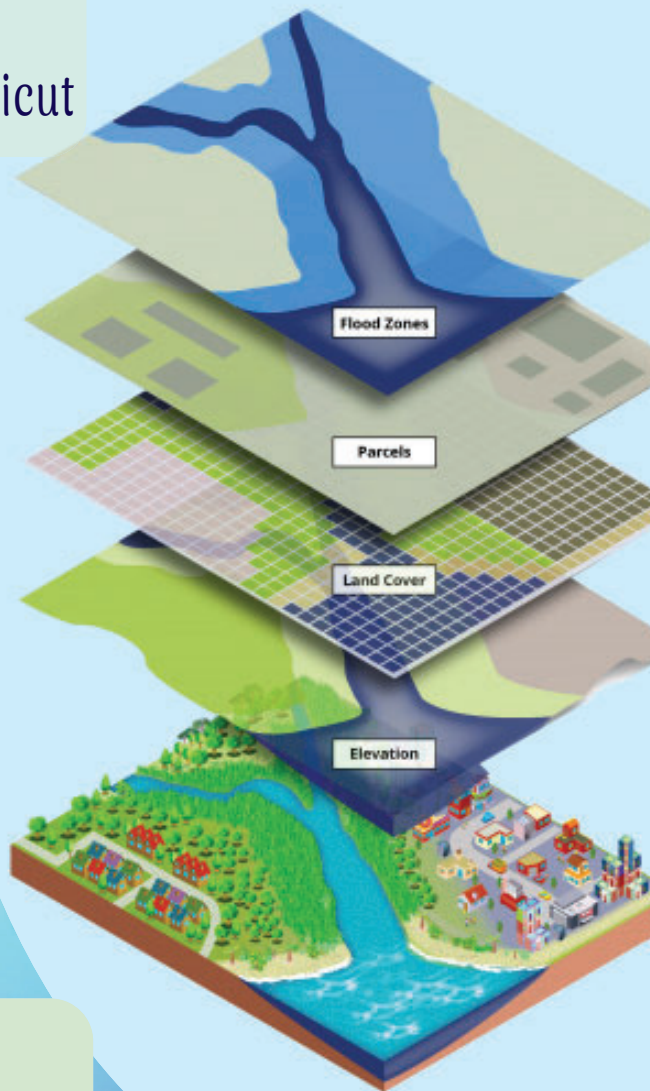

Day two of the workshop began with Session IV at 10:00 am, addressing remote sensing applications in plant sciences. This session provided participants with valuable knowledge on


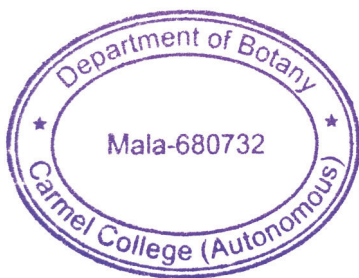
utilizing remote sensing data for botanical research purposes. A tea break followed at 11:00 am, allowing participants to network and interact with fellow attendees.

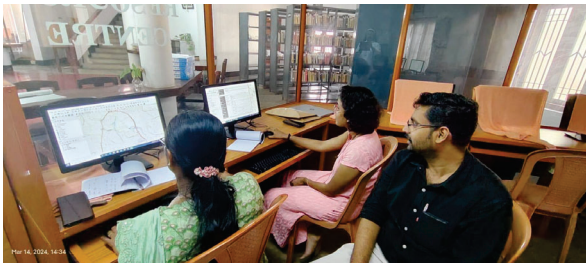

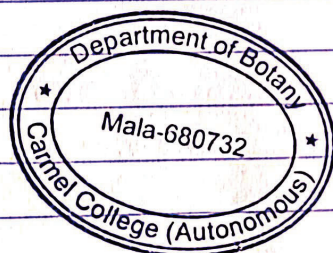
