ACADEMIC YEAR 2017-18

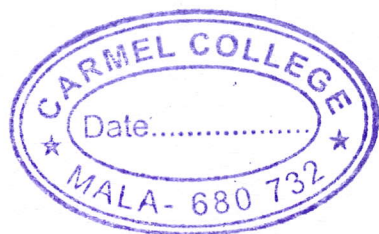
Diploma in computer applications (DCA) has been outlined for candidates for to enhance their knowledge in computer applications. - Create documents using Word processor, Spreadsheet and Presentation Software.
- Understanding computer networks, the Internet and they will also learn about browsing the internet, content search and email.
- Use a computer to improve existing skills and learn new skills

During the Academic year 2017-18, 2 students enrolled in the course and they cleared and hired by good companies.

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VALUES AND SOCIETY

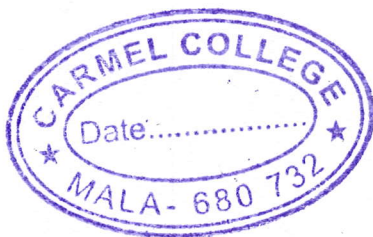
ACADEMIC YEAR 2017 - 2018

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VALUES FOR SUCCESSFUL LIVING

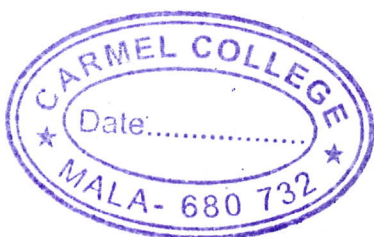
ACADEMIC YEAR 2017 – 2018
