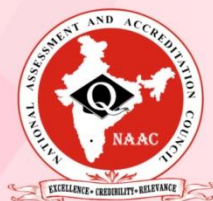

**ORDER**

The Principal, Carmel College, Mala,Thrissur, vide paper read as 1st above, has submitted an application for starting the new Self-financing/Unaided courses of M.Com and MSc. Chemistry for the academic year 2015-16.

Accordingly, the District Level Inspection Commission from the University conducted inspection at the college on 4.3.2015 and vide paper read as 2nd, recommended for starting the Self financing courses of M.Com (15) and MSc Chemistry,(10) for the academic year 2015-16.

The University vide paper read as 3rd above, considered the Reports of the District Level Inspection Commission and has recommended the above mentioned courses at Carmel College,Mala,Thrissur and forwarded to the Govt. for concurrence.

In view of the recommendation from the University, the Govt. have granted Administrative Sanction and NOC for starting the new Selffinancing/Unaided courses of M.Com(15) and MSc Chemistry(10) for the academic year 2015-16 vide G.O.read as 4. after entering an agreement with the Educational agency.

The Principal of the College vide paper read as 5th, remitted an amount of Rs.20,000/-(Twenty thousand only) towards Affiliation fee to the courses vide Challan No.16€2562 dated 23-6-2015.

The Principal of the College has also submitted a Notarised Undertaking in Stamp paper worth Rs.500/- duly signed by the Manager and Principal of the college and has requested to grant Additional Affiliation for starting the new Self-financing/Unaided courses of MCom (15) and MSc Chemistry (10) at Carmel College ,Mala,Thrissur,for the academic year 2015-16.

As per the paper read as 6th, the Syndicate approved the recommendations of the DLIC to grant Additional Affiliation to the new Self-financing/Unaided courses of M.Corr (15) and MSc Chemistry (10) at Carmel College,Mala, Thrissur for the academic year 2015-16 and also resolved to authorize the Vice Chancellor to approve new courses based on the recommendation of DLIC.

Further, as per the syndicate decision dated 03-07-15, Item No. 2015-819\*, the syndicate authorized the Honourable Vice Chancellor to sanction courses, colleges and increase of seats as per recommendation of the DLIC.

Sanction has therefore been accorded by the Vice Chancellor on 14-07-15, vide paper read as 7th above, to grant Additional Affiliation for starting the new Self-financing/Unaided courses of MCom (15) and MSc Chemistry (10) at Carmel College, Mala, Thrissur for the academic year 2015-16.



The teachers utilised for the courses will not be paid by Govt.





ORDER

The University Grants Commission vide paper read as first has informed the granting of approval for the proposal submitted by various colleges, for introducing new B.Voc programmes under National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) from the academic year 2018-19, in compliance with the terms and conditions laid down in the guidelines for providing Skill-based Education under National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF).

2. Based on the approval from the UGC, the Principals of concerned colleges, vide the papere read as second, have submitted applications in the statutory form and requested to issue necessary orders for granting provisional affiliation to these programmes from the 2018-19 academic year. The Principals of Farook College, Kozhikode and WMO Arts & Science College, Muttill, Wayanad have informed their unwillingness to start the programme during the academic year 2018-19.
3. The belated submission of applications require the issuance of a notification, by the Hon'ble Chancellor, under the provisions in Chapter XVIII of the CU Act 1975, sub section (2) granting extension of time upto the date proposed by the University for consideration of the application for starting the programme. As per papers read as third above, the Secretary to the Chancellor was requested to consider the belated applications and to issue a notification granting extension of time for consideration of the applications for affiliation of the new programmes for the academic year 2018-19.
4. Vide reference fourth, the Hon'ble Chancellor is pleased to issue a notification, extending the period up to 15.11.2018, within which the Syndicate shall consider the application for granting additional affiliation to the new programmes at these colleges for the academic year 2018-19.
5. The DLIC for the districts Thrissur, Malappuram & Wayanad have conducted inspection at these colleges and recommended the UGC aided BVoc programmes with an intake of 50 students each in

11 colleges, vide paper read as fifth. DLIC, Malappuram has not recommended the BVoc programme in Sullamussalam Arabic college, Areacode due to the lack of sufficient infrastructural facilities in the college. Further, DLIC Malappuram has recommended only one BVoc programme ie. BVoc Accounting & Taxation at Sullamussalam Science College, Areacode and not recommended the programme BVoc Instrumentation.

5. Accordingly, the Syndicate at its meeting on 05.11.2018 considered the applications along with the inspection report submitted by the concerned DLICs and approved the reports for starting BVoc Programmes (approved and aided by the UGC) for the academic year 2018-19.

6. Further, the list of affiliated colleges in Thrissur, Malappuram, Wayanad districts, under the jurisdiction of the University who have applied for starting new B.Voc programmes for the academic year 2018-19, as approved by the UGC and duly recommended by the University was forwarded to the Govt. of Kerala, as per the paper sixth, for consideration and obtaining the views of the Government as stipulated in Chapter-23, 9 (g), CUFS 1977.

7. The Govt. vide the Order read as seventh has granted the NOC for starting B Voc programmes at various colleges in , Thrissur, Malappuram & Wayanad districts under the University of Calicut as detailed in the table under para 10 (i).

8. The Principals of the colleges concerned, vide papers read as eighth, have submitted the required amount towards affiliation fee and requested for additional affiliation to the new B.Voc programmes w.e.f the academic year 2018-19. The Principal, Sullamusallam Science College, Areacode has requested provisional affiliation to the B.Voc programme for the academic year 2018-19, with permission to start the classes from the academic year 2019-20. All the Principals have submitted notarised affidavit in the required format and also an undertaking stating that necessary arrangements will be made to provide additional classes to the students for compensating the lost classes, if any, due to the belated commencement of the programme during 2018-19.

9. Considering the matter in detail, the Vice Chancellor on 21.01.2019 ordered, subject to ratification by the Syndicate, to grant provisional affiliation to the new UGC-aided B.Voc programmes in these colleges for the year 2018-19. Since the Centralized Admission Process (CAP) for the programmes has already been completed, sanction has also been accorded to admit students in conventional mode, as per the Schedule of Admission provided thereunder.



**ORDER**

1. The University Grants Commission (UGC) has launched a scheme on skills development based Higher Education, as part of college/university education, leading to Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc.) Degree with multiple exits such as Diploma/Advanced Diploma under the National Skills Qualification Framework. Many affiliated colleges under the university of calicut submitted proposals to UGC for commencing B Voc programmes in their colleges.
2. As per paper read 1st above , the UGC, New Delhi has approved the proposals of six Colleges under this University for starting B.Voc Courses with a direction to commence the classes in 2014-15 academic year itself. The colleges and programmes sanctioned are detailed below.

A meeting of the Principals as well as the teachers in charge of the B.Voc Programme was convened on 19/06/2014 to discuss the various aspects such as approval of Syllabi, affiliation of Courses etc of B.Voc Programmes and resolved to form a Co-ordination Committee comprising of the teachers concerned, Director, College Development Council and DR, General and Academic Branch IV for proper co-ordination of the preparation of Syllabi and related matters.

4. Subsequently, the Co-ordination Committee met on 26/06/2014, discussed the draft Regulations for B.Voc courses prepared by the faculty of Farook College, Calicut and suggested necessary modifications. The Draft Regulation was then placed before the Steering Committee on CBCSS UG in its meeting held on 05.09.2014. As recommended by the CBCSS UG Steering Committee, a new Committee, exclusively for the Study/Preparation and approval of Regulations of B.Voc Programme was constituted with Dr. K M Naseer, Member of the Syndicate as the Convenor and the committee which met on 07.10.2014 recommended to start the admissions to B Voc programmes on 24.10.2014 and the classes on 27.10.2014. The Vice Chancellor approved the minutes of the committee exercising the powers of the Academic council in view of exigency and implemented the Regulations in the University from 2014' admission onwards vide UO No.9809/2014/Admn dt. 23.10.2014.

5. Vide paper 5 read above, the colleges have submitted applications for affiliation of the B Voc programmes remitting the required fee. Since B Voc Programmes are envisaged by the UGC as a special one-time scheme for skill development as part of National Skills Qualification Framework with strict direction to start the programme in 2014-2015 itself, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor has ordered on 04-11-14, to place the matter of granting affiliation to the courses as a special case, before the Syndicate for consideration.

6. Accordingly the meeting of the Syndicate held on 10/11/2014 considered the granting of affiliation to Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc) Programmes sanctioned by the UGC in colleges affiliated to Calicut University and resolved vide item No. 2014-938 to approve the same and to grant affiliation from the academic year 2014-15 onwards.

4. Meanwhile the Inspection Commission, constituted for conducting inspection in the College, submitted its report dated 28.01.2020 recommending B.Voc. Agriculture programme at Carmel College, Mala, Thrissur with an intake of 40 students and the recommendation of the University was forwarded to the Government vide reference cited seventh, for ascertaining the views of the Government.

5. The College has submitted affidavit in the prescribed format, No Objection Certificate issued from Government and challan receipt towards affiliation fee. The College has also submitted an undertaking to the effect that the College shall compensate all the lost working days as compensatory days during vacation and on Saturdays.

6. The Syndicate considered the report of inspection dated 28.01.2020 and No Objection Certificate issued from Government in its meeting held on 18.03.2020 and approved the same vide reference cited ninth.

7. Considering the above, the Vice Chancellor, on 16.04.2020, has ordered to implement the above decision of the Syndicate.

8. Orders are, therefore, issued for granting provisional affiliation to B.Voc. Agriculture programme at Carmel College Mala, Thrissur with an intake of **40 students** for the academic year 2019-20.

9. The provisional affiliation so granted is subject to the following terms and conditions.



- Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2019-20.
- The College has to apply for continuation of provisional affiliation for the ensuing academic year by remitting the fee fixed by the University. - The management should abide by the provisions of the University Act, Statutes and Regulations of the University with regard to admission of students, collection of fee, etc.
- Selection and admission shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University/Government and on the directions issued by the University/Government from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will automatically be cancelled.
- The conduct of University Examinations of any sort including that of SDE Examinations is compulsory and binding on all Colleges affiliated to the University of Calicut.
- The Principal shall strictly follow the approved syllabii, which are available in the University website ([www.uoc.ac.in](http://www.uoc.ac.in)) for selecting the complementary/common courses.
- In the light of the directions of the Supreme Court of India in WP(C) No. 656/1998, the Institution shall take appropriate measures for the prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent such instances, appropriate action including withdrawal of affiliation of the College will be initiated.

10. The list of colleges which have renewed their provisional affiliation or applied for continuation of provisional affiliation will be forwarded to the office of the Controller of Examinations to ensure that examinations are not conducted in those colleges which do not have valid affiliation orders.

In the University Order read as first paper above, provisional affiliation was granted for starting degree courses in B.Sc(Mathematics) with Statistics and Mathematical Economics as subsidiaries and B.A(Sociology) with History and Political Science as subsidiaries in the Carmel College, Mala during the academic year 1984-85 with an intake of 24 and 30 students respectively.
