## **ORDER**

As per the paper read (1) above, a Committee was constituted to prepare the guidelines for Ph.D. admission of any time category candidates.

As per the paper read (2) above, the Committee constituted to prepare the guidelines for Ph.D. admission of any time category candidates held on 10.01.2023, approved the following guidelines for the Ph.D admission of any time category candidates.

## Procedure for admission.

- a. The vacancy should be notified by the University/Research Centre.
- b. The eligible candidates should report at the research centre within the date and time fixed by the University/Research Centres.
- c. The vacancy ceases to exist after the last date fixed for reporting.
- d. Interview should be conducted by the Research Centres and rank list should be published on the website and notice board of the Research Centre.
- e. CAP ID (created during the concerned admission year) is mandatory for all candidates at the time of admission,
- f. The admission procedure including the conduct of RAC should be completed within 30 days from the last date fixed for reporting for admission.
- g. The admission should be granted in strict compliance of the reservation roster issued by the University vide U.O.No. 19032/2022/Admn dated 07.10.2022.
- h. Those who have already submitted their application through DoA can also apply for these new vacancies.
- i. The Research Centres can admit the candidates after issuing a joining memo in the format prescribed by the University.
- j. After joining the candidate in the Research Centre, the proposal for issuing the final registration

order should be submitted by the candidate through the ONLINE RESEARCH PORTAL. The supervisor/ guide and the Head of the Research Centre should verify the details and documents entered by the candidates in the portal and forward the same to the DoR with proper certification. (An online familiarisation session will be provided to the Research Supervisors and the Heads of the Research Centre on the Online Research Portal)

k. The DoR will issue the final registration order after verifying the details/documents forwarded by the Head of the Research Centre granting registration from the date of joining in the research centre, if the proposal is in order.

I. Foreign Nationals may be exempted from all the above procedures and they may be admitted to Ph.D. programme anytime during the academic year depending on the willingness/availability of guides.

Sanction has been accorded by the Vice Chancellor, as per paper read (3) above, to implement the minutes of the committee constituted to prepare the guidelines for Ph.D. admission of any time category candidates

#### **ORDER**

As per reference cited 1<sup>st</sup> above, a Committee has been constituted for the preparation of the guidelines for the Second Stage Ph.D. Admission Process and Ph.D. Admission Reservation Roster. As per the reference cited 2<sup>nd</sup> above, the Committee for preparation of Reservation Roster for Ph.D. Admission Process has resolved as follows:

- 1. The Research Centres should maintain register of the reported vacancies with date of occurrence.
- 2. In the case of Institution/Centres with multiple disciplines reservation shall be applied discipline wise.
- 3. Where sufficient numbers of candidates belonging to a reserved category are not available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them in the admission, the vacancies shall be filled by candidates belonging to other communities next in the reservation roster, treating these vacancies as "backlog vacancies". In the subsequent admission year when admissions are made for the vacancies of that year (called the current vacancies), the backlog vacancies of reserved categories will also be announced for admission. All the backlog vacancies reserved for categories will be filled up by the candidates belonging to the category concerned without any restriction whatsoever as they belong to distinct group of backlog vacancies of categories. Vacancies reserved for various categories which could not be filled up and are carried forward as backlog vacancies and remain unfilled in the following admission year also, will be carried forward as backlog vacancies for subsequent admission year(s) as long as these are not filled by candidates of the category for which these are reserved.

As per the reference cited 3<sup>rd</sup> above, the Vice Chancellor has granted permission to implement the minutes of the Committee for Reservation Roster for Ph.D. Admission Process.

The Ph.D. Admission Reservation Roster has been approved by the Vice Chancellor, as per the reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited above.

The approved Reservation Roster for Ph.D. Admission is appended herewith.
