

ONE DAY AWARENESS PROGRAMME "Healthy Youth through healthy food" CARMEL COLLEGE, MALA

The class was lead by Dr.Ambily K.M, Lecturer, Vimala College, Thrissur. The topic was "Healthy Youth through healthy food" .She explained that nutrients are those which obtained from the food which is used for the growth and building purpose of the body. They are protein, carbohydrate, minerals, vitamins and water. Food provides energy for the proper the functioning of the body. So each day we require cereals, vegetables fruits, milk meat etc.

Through over eating the excess energy will deposit in the form of fat and will leads to the overweight and cholesterol, attack etc. She advised the house wives to provide steam cooked foods like eddaly, dosa, tapioca, etc to the kids. She explained the need of including cereals in the breakfast.

It is better to include fiber containing food to reduce cancer risk. They will clean our digestive system and exclude the accumulated cancer causing agents. Similarly we have to avoid the processed food and include more original and natural food items from our surroundings which will be rich in nutrients and vitamins to become healthier.

She reminded us to clean the vegetables before cooking without losing the nutrients and if possible to consume raw vegetables. Drinking more water helps to remove the toxic substances from our body and to help the multiplication of cancerous cells in the body. She also advised to reduce the usage of over salted, over sugared items like pickles, cakes, and coloured food items and fast food to reduce the health problems.

She advised to cook in steel utensils and to avoid cooking in the aluminum vessels to overcome the risk of Alzheimer disease.

The programme was presided over by Dr.Sr.Lijo our Principal. Dr.Sr.Jassentha, Dr.Sr.Sr.ochuthressia, Kumari Athira Thomas etcwere there on the diocese.

After the inaugural session there was a class on the the same topic by Dr.K.G.Radhakrishnan. He stressed about the goodness of our traditional food and their importance. He also discussed about the changed food habit and its consequences. In the olden days we have som many vegetable sources like solanum tuberosum, elephant foot yam, jack fruit, mango, drum stick leaves, amaranthus etc and the health gained by their consumption is far far better than those obtained from fast food consumption.

When we are consuming the traditional food like "Nadan Sadya" we are getting almost all the nutrients from the various items oft the sadya but it is laking in the items like Biriyani, Burger etc. More than that thewy are high calorie food and stores additional energy in the form of fat which cause the obesity and other diseases like cholesterol etc.

He emphasized on the dangerous effect of coloured food . In ice creams, ladu , jilebi and other similar food items there is poisonous substances imparting the sweetness and flavor which will destroy our health. He advised to reduce the use of such junk food.

He pointed out the role of salt in the food. According to him over usage of salt will create obesity, pressure etc. Similarly over usage of sweets and candies will create diabetics and cancer like conditions.



The root cause of the Anemia in majority of women is lack of iron in the food. So he inspired us to include lot of iron sources like amaranth, and other leafy vegetables in the food. It is also good for the health of eye. He encouraged cooking curries in the iron pots.

Over eating causes over weight in women. He also pointed out the need of including more pulses in the food to get more protein. We have to consume only what is necessary for us avoid to become a part of consumerism. He also explained how the social evils like smoking, alcohol consumption badly affect the man socially, mentally and physically.
