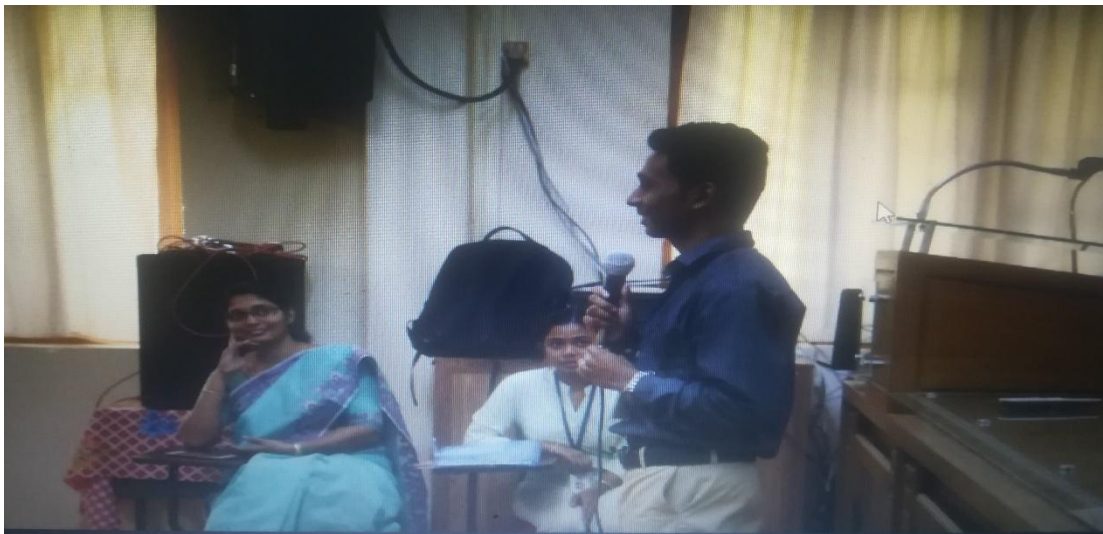

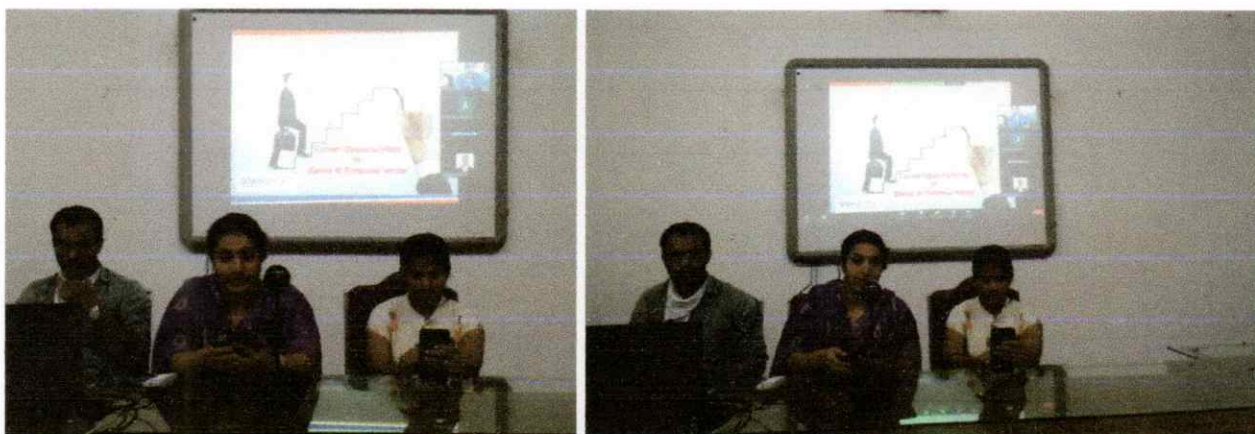

On 26<sup>th</sup> June 2020, the Career Guidance and Placement Cell and Department of English jointly organized a Webinar on “IPR (Intellectual Property Rights)”. Adv. Sreekala Vivek, Notary Public, High Court, Ernakulam was the Resource Person.



Adv. Sreekala Vivek stated that intellectual property rights (IPR) are legal rights aimed at protecting the creations of the intellect, such as inventions, the appearance of products, literary, artistic and scientific works and signs, among others. She added that the protection of IPR allows the innovator, brand owner, patent holder and copyright holder to benefit from his/her work, labor and investment, which does not mean monopoly of the intellect. Such rights are set out in the International Declaration of Human Rights, which provides for the right to benefit from the protection of the moral and physical interests resulting from the right holder’s work; literal or artistic product. She also explained about the four different types of IP - four distinct types—copyrights, trademarks, patents, and trade secrets. IPR offers due recognition to the creators and inventors.

The State IT Mission decided to conduct live webcasting from polling booths in North Kerala in association with Keltron, BSNL, Akshaya and KSEB for the Kerala Legislative Assembly Election 2021 to streamline the election process.
