

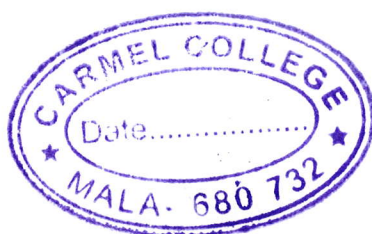
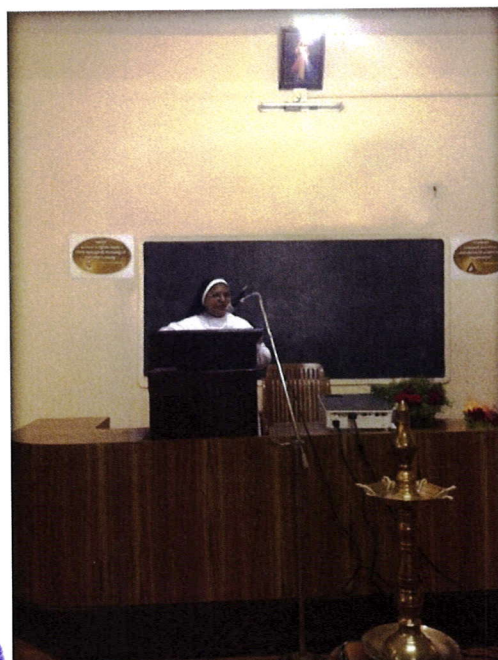
Code of Conduct committee - Activity Report
