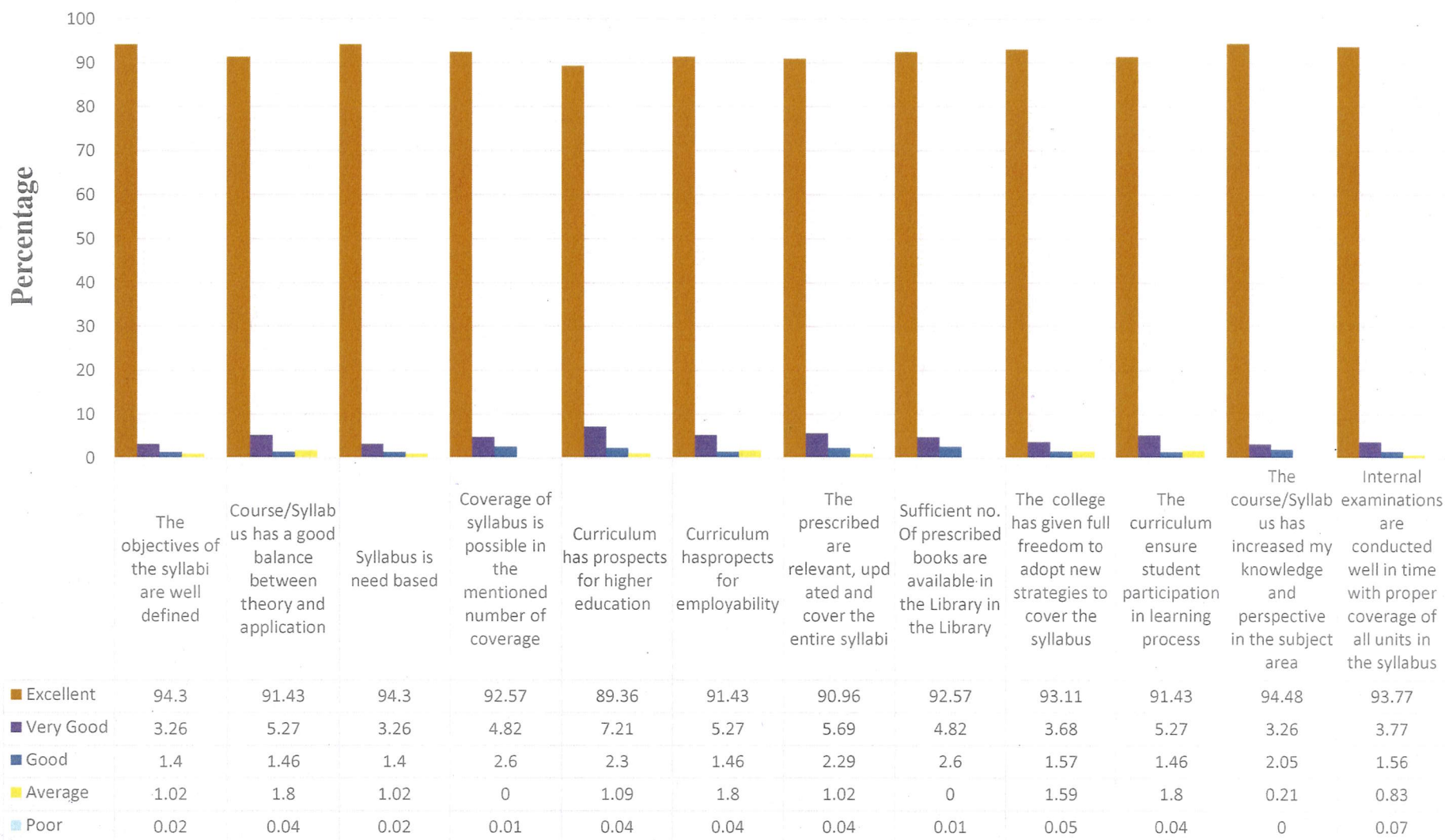

Analysis of Teachers' Feedback on Curriculum

2016-2017

The teacher feedback is a reflection of the employee satisfaction survey. The feedback results reveal that most of the teachers are convinced of the objectives of the syllabi being well defined and on par with high standards. 96.71% of teachers appreciate the course content and find the syllabus prescribed as having a good balance between theory and application. The majority of the teachers find the syllabus as need-based.

Teachers univocally opine that the coverage of the syllabus is possible within the stipulated time. Most of the teachers have found the curriculum as promising to pursue higher education and secure a career. The teachers are undivided in their opinion about the prescribed texts being relevant, updated, and adequate to cover the entire syllabi. All teachers are satisfied with the library facilities and availability of curriculum-prescribed books and auxiliary study materials.

The teachers wholeheartedly say that the college has given full freedom to adopt new strategies to cover the syllabus. More than 91% of teachers are well content with the curriculum, which ensures student participation in the learning process. All teachers ascertain that the syllabus has increased their knowledge and perspective in the subject area. The survey shows that all teachers are satisfied with the conduct of the internal examinations being conducted on time with proper coverage of all units in the syllabus.



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
