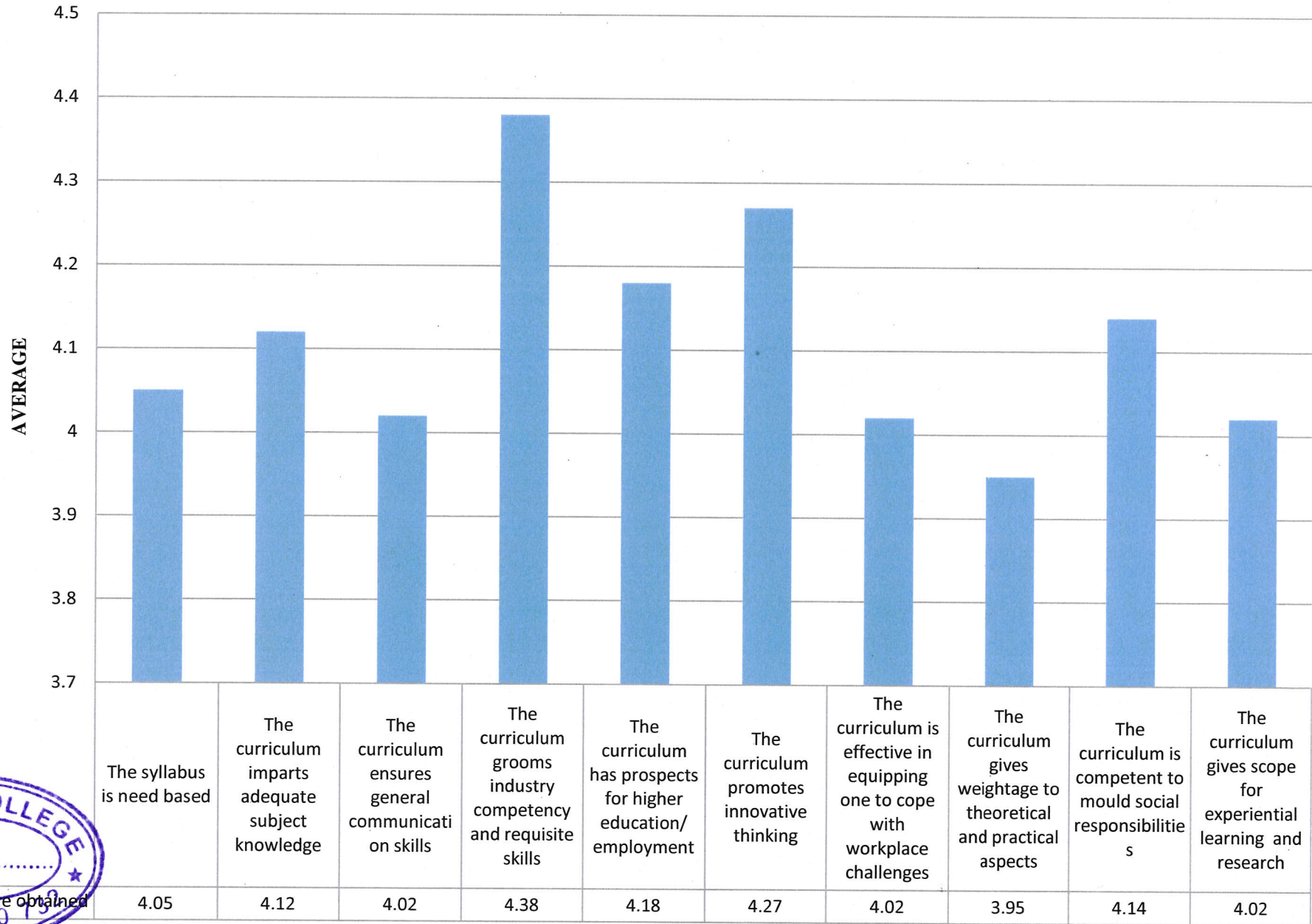


Employers' Feedback on Curriculum 2018-2019

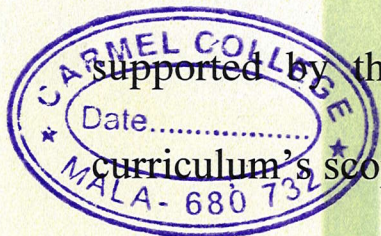

Analysis of Employers' Feedback Analysis

2018-2019

The feedback collected from employers on the curriculum and performance of their employees reveals the quality of the teaching-learning process and curriculum that is followed in our institution. Employers opine that the curriculum studied by their employees is need-based. Basic subject knowledge of employee has received an above-average score of 4.12. A score of 4.02 is obtained for the general communication skills of employees. All respondents strongly agree that the curriculum grooms industry competency and requisite skills. The score of 4.18 reveals that most of the respondents agree with the curriculum's prospects for higher education/employment. Most of the respondents regard the curriculum as effective in promoting innovative thinking. Employers opine that the curriculum studied by the employee is effective in equipping them to cope with workplace challenges. The majority of the employers find that the curriculum assures an equal weightage to theoretical and practical aspects. The competency of the curriculum to mould social responsibility is supported by the employers, having obtained a score of 4.14. The respondents positively consider the curriculum's scope in ascertaining experiential learning and research.
