

Analysis of Students' Feedback on Curriculum 2018-2019

The Students' feedback reflects the quality of the institution in a nutshell. Course wise regular student feedback is collected on the curriculum as an evaluation report for both faculty and IQAC to execute measures for improvement. An average of 3.74 strongly agrees to the parameter on the suitability of the syllabus to the course whereas an average of 3.6 strongly affirms that the syllabus generated interest in the subject area.

Most of the students have felt that topics for competitive exams are included in the syllabus. An average 3.81 score for a strong agreement has been obtained regarding library facilities including prescribed books and reference materials. The majority of the students felt that the curriculum has prospects for higher education, and an average of 3.35 was obtained regarding the effectiveness of the present curriculum in providing employment. The majority of the students felt that the present curriculum provided a boost in the development of society.
