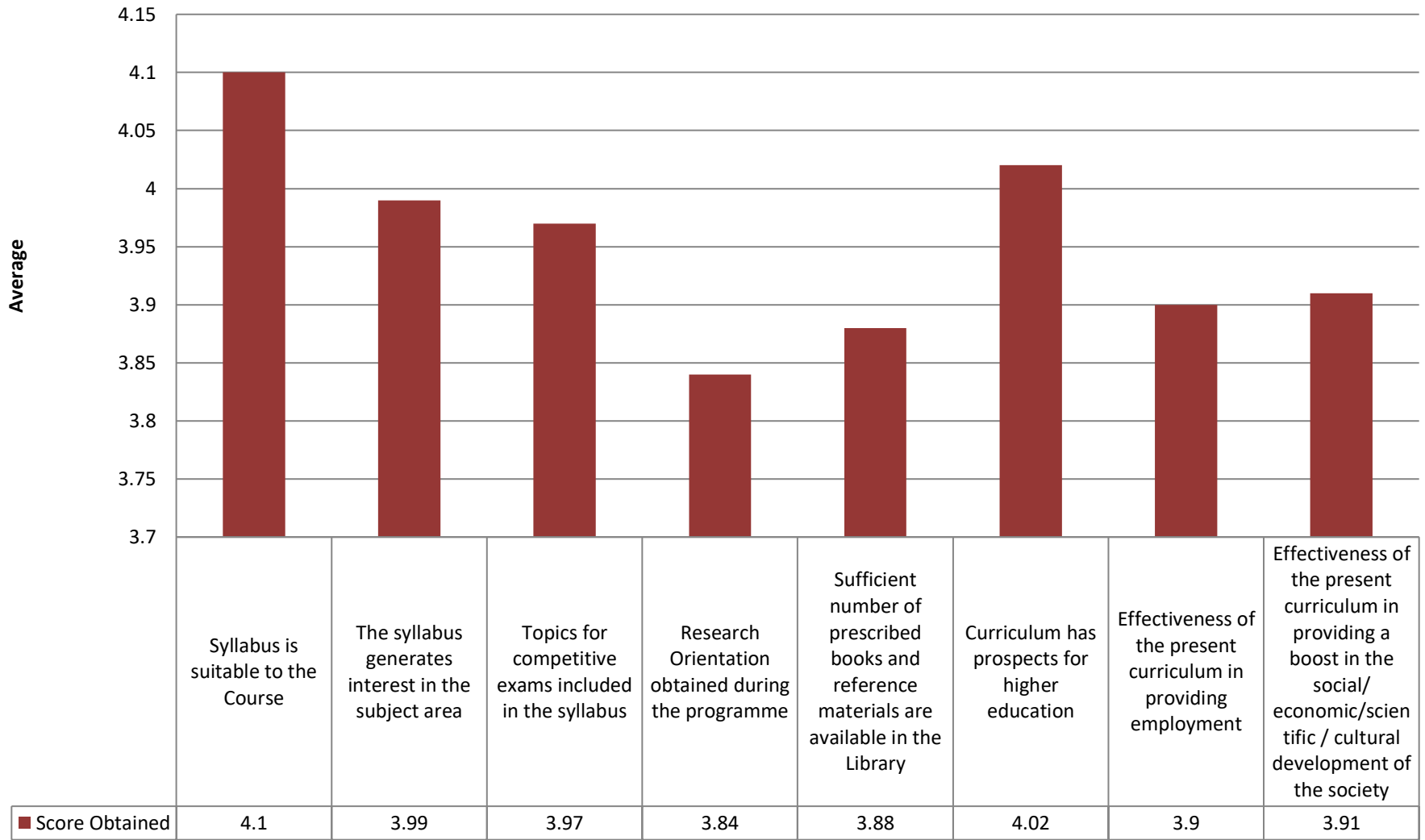


Students' Feedback on Curriculum 2020-2021





Analysis of Students' feedback on curriculum

2020-2021

Students are the pillars of strength of all academic institutions. Reputation of a college lies in the opinion of its students. The IQAC collected feedback from the students on the process of curriculum delivery. An average score of 4.1 given by the students in response to the question asked with regards to the updating and suitability of the syllabus of the various programmes. An average score of 3.99 was given by the students in agreement of the opinion that the syllabus was capable of generating an interest in the subject area.

Most of the students agreed that the topics for the competitive exams are covered in the syllabus and affirm that they obtained encouragement for research during the programme. A score of 3.88 is obtained for the extent of availability of prescribed books and reference materials in the library. Competency of the curriculum in higher education and employment generation is confirmed by the students with a score of 4 and 3.9 respectively. Most of the students think that the curriculum has the potential to contribute to the development of the society.
