

Analysis of Parents Feedback on curriculum 2021-2022

Based on the feedback from Parents, the contemporary relevance of the curriculum obtained a high score of 4.1. Majority of the parents agree that the syllabus is suitable for all the concerned programmes. An average score of 4.12 rating the scope of the respective programmes for higher studies ensures the quality of the syllabus. Parents felt that the curriculum lays emphasis on humanitarian values and social responsibilities which is a much needed quality in all the children. Most of the parents are highly satisfied with the timely conduct of the internal examinations and evaluation. A score of 4.04 is given to the enhancement of competency levels in students. A large number of the respondents are satisfied with the functioning of the library. They gave a score of 4.11 to the effectiveness of infrastructural and laboratory facilities in the teaching learning process. The score of 3.97 shows that parents are satisfied with the use of ICT in the rendering of curriculum. However, there is definitely scope for improvement. Most of the parents believe that the curriculum is capable of bringing about the holistic development of students.
