Analysis of Students feedback on curriculum 2021-22

Students are the real stakeholders as well as the actualjudges of the performance of a teacher, department and institution. Reputation of a college lies in the opinion of its students. The IQAC collected feedback from the students on the process of curriculum delivery. A score of 4.1 clearly indicated the satisfaction level of students with regards the syllabus of the various courses that they were studying under their programme. An average of 4.22 students vouched for the inclusion of the latest topics, especially those required for attempting competitive examination, also being covered as part of the syllabus. A score of 3.79 for research orientation was given, indicating a scope for improvement. Students were satisfied with the availability of required books and references in the college library. A large number of students believed in the employability potential of their programme, the score was 4.24. However, a score of 3.99 shows that the students seemed a little doubtful about the coverage of the programme from the point of view of higher education. The students gave the same score when asked about the relevance of their programme with regards to the socio-economic and political development of the society.
