



Action Taken Report 2022-23

- Although the present curricula meets the requirements of the employers, new courses have been introduced which enhance the ability of students in the employment sector. Certificate courses and skill development programmes were introduced to equip students according to the contemporary needs of the industry.
- From the feedback obtained from teachers, it is understood that innovative teaching methods have enhanced the quality of teaching and the regular and timely assessments have improved the learning process.
- Taking the students' feedback into account, classes were arranged to improve their competitive skills. Coaching classes for PSC, SSC, UPSC and NET exams were conducted for ambitious students. Courses which provide employability were also conducted with minimal fees through different collaborations.
- Programmes were conducted to train the final year students to face interviews.
- In order to meet the requirements of the new era, new courses were introduced in the B.Voc Programmes ie, Agriculture, BFSI, Accounting&Taxation, Software Development, Fashion Technology & Multimedia.
