




Employer Feedback on Curriculum 2022-2023





Analysis of Employer's Feedback on curriculum 2022-2023

The assessment of curriculum quality and need-based revision is conducted by means of employer input. With an average score of 4.31, the majority of employers believed that the curriculum can provide a basic understanding of the subjects. They awarded the general communication skill acquired through the curriculum a score of 4.28. They are satisfied with the employees' organizational, planning, and leadership abilities as well as their managerial abilities. Employers assigned scores of 4.03 and 4.1 for teamwork performance and relationships with coworkers, respectively. They value the employees' willingness to take on more duties and their participation in social events. The performance is scored as having an overall impression of 4.13.

Lots of companies believe that the curriculum is relevant to the profession or the future goals of the students and has the power to instill values. A rating of 3.93 indicates that the curriculum satisfies industry standards. They think the curriculum emphasizes exposure to theory and practical application. The average score that employers assign to the curriculum's ability to shape social responsibility is 4.17. It is clear from the majority of responses that employers believe curriculum is need-based and can help students grow academically and socially
