Executive Summary

The Academic Audit for the year 2019-20 has been undertaken with the objective of appraising the performance of each department's quality academic undertakings that contribute to student progress and enhance the institutional profile. The panel of external experts constituted by IQAC for Academic Audit conducted a detailed assessment of the Self-Study Report produced by the departments and remarked favorably on the various learner-centric initiatives of departments. The team gave valuable suggestions on measures/strategies that can be incorporated and the same has been consolidated by the Committee Members of IQAC as follows:

- Steps should be taken to regularize self-financing UG and PG Programmes like B.Sc. Zoology, B.Com, B.A. Political Science, M.A. English, M. Sc. Chemistry and M. Sc. Mathematics
- As the college has well-maintained infrastructural facilities for physical education, steps should be taken to introduce B. P. Ed Programme and Diploma in Physical Education
- It is highly appreciable to start job-oriented Diploma or Short term need-based Certificate Programmes in foreign languages like French, German, Italian, Spanish, Japanese, Arabic and Russian with multi-media language lab
- Students should be encouraged to do paper presentations in the national/ international seminars, conferences, symposiums and the like
- Faculty and students are to be encouraged to publish more research articles in UGC Care-listed journals as well as to publish ISBN Books or Chapters in ISBN Books
- Faculty and students are to be encouraged to take multidisciplinary-funded projects
- Organize more extension and consultancy service programmes for general cause
- Provision for lift facility in the construction of new academic block



- More functional MoU-s with other institutions, firms and agencies by departments
- More alumni involved activities and events are to be organized
- Besides the ongoing entrepreneurship skills development programmes, efforts should be taken at the college level to start several schemes for “Earn and Learn” for students.
- Ensure more student placements
