The Black Death, which wiped out over one-third of Europe's population, was actually spread by rats.

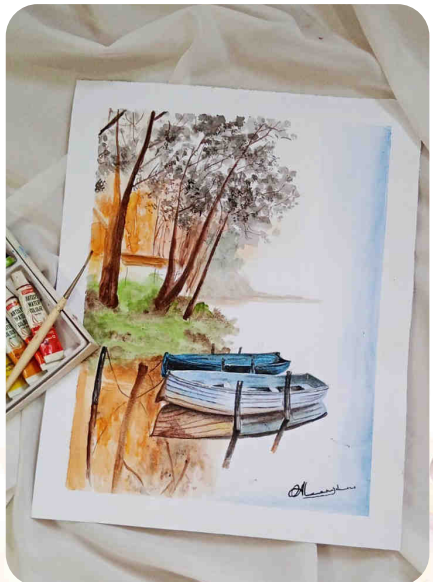
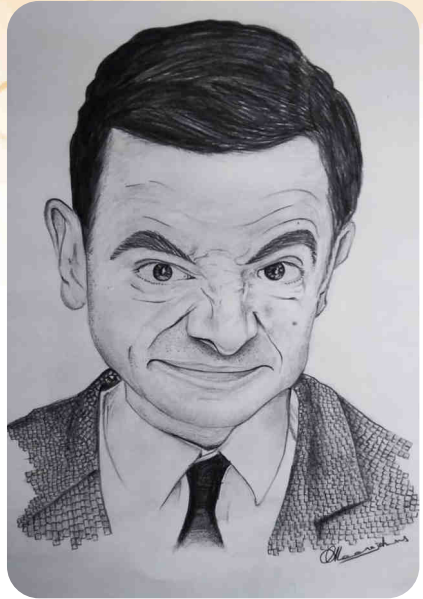
4. A horse became a Senator in Ancient Rome.

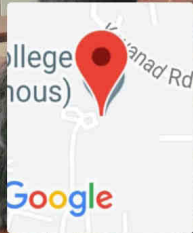

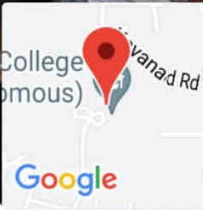

Journey Ends: A Journey between Life and Death

Journey Ends or Yathrayude Anthyam is a film directed by well-known Malayalam film Director K. G. George. As a director, he always chooses to take unique themes in his works. Portrayed in a simple and realistic way, this film depicts the relationship between a writer and his friend, elderly intellectual man living in a remote village. The story unfolds through the journey of the writer to meet his friend.

Actor Bharath Murali played the leading role of the writer. The story narrated through mind monologues of the writer is a classic narrative technique by George. The lens of the film was preoccupied with the social perspective of the modernized Kerala. The changes which took place in and around, the transformation slowly appearing in the country side and the attitudes and lives of the people were marked in detail.

The theme of the story is transcendental, about life, death and the journey between. And the film's narrative is non-linear. George takes the subject of death as subdued, objective and intellectual. A melodramatic presentation is not there in his work, though that was the usual style of presentation of the film makers during the 1980s.

The death first enters halfway into the film on a Christmas night as the death of Abraham's son-in-law. The second time death appears with the hint of the universality. It emphasized and exposed the uncertainty of life. The climax of the film narrates another death, the death of Abraham, which clearly mirrors that death is an entity which is inevitable in the life. George always preferred different subjects to stereotyped ones for his film which clearly depicts the human conflicts and these films are still engaging and enchanting to the viewers. Yathrayude Anthyam is one of his most simplest works, which offers a realistic glimpse of life.
