From the farsighted vision and undying perseverance of our foundress Sr. Aurea CMC, Carmel College, managed by CMC Udaya Educational society, has evolved carving an indelible mark as an institution of academic repute and excellence. For over 41 years, Carmel College has stood the ground fulfilling her motto 'light and love' by empowering young women through quality education, skill development initiatives, and judicious mentoring, to become self-reliant, competent and ethically driven individuals. The academic year 2022-23 has been momentous for Carmel College, owing to two significant achievements – Awarding of Autonomous Status and Re-accreditation by NAAC with 'A' grade in the fourth cycle. Having achieved this tremendous feat is an impetus to tirelessly work towards better heights of academic excellence.

At present, the college with 19 Departments, offers 19 UG programmes including 6 B.Voc programmes and 10 PG programmes which includes 2 M.Voc programmes and 1 Integrated programme. and also the Research Centre of Botany with a student strength of around 1400. Additionally, Diploma courses under Community College, C-DIT courses under Carmel Computer Academy, various Certificate courses including value education offered by the Christian Chair under Calicut University and extension courses by Carmel Extension Centre for Women are offered to learners of all age groups.

The undying devotion and teamwork of 106 faculty who excel in their respective disciplines and 46 administrative staff have significantly contributed to elevating the stature of our institution as one to be reckoned with. Amongst them 17 are M.Phil Degree holders, 22 are PhD holders and 11 are pursuing their doctoral degree.

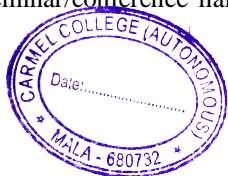
Among the meritorious achievements of the year, the institution was awarded "Best institution doing agriculture in Mala Panchayat", Premium membership from the ICT Academy of Kerala, Selected for the first phase of 'Kerala Skills Express Campaign' under the Kerala Knowledge academy, Awarded under 'Mikav 2022' by Kodungaloor MLA and received 3.5 star rating for the Institution Innovation Council. The college has also signed 17 MoUs this year with various colleges across the country.

Carmel College (Autonomous) foregrounds quality enhancement in all spheres of its engagement with the stakeholders and in assuring the same, the IQAC plays a cardinal role. Periodic conduct of workshops and training programmes to fine-tune the professional acumen of the faculty has been organized by the IQAC, and this year's prime focal area has been the digitalization of academic and administrative activities through efficient employment of MIS. As part of this initiative the non-teaching staff also attended training and refresher courses this year. A functional MoU with Linways Technology Pvt. Ltd. and IPSr Solutions Ltd. also accelerated Carmel's journey to smart campus.

The research cell encourages the staff to explore research possibilities, undertake research projects and identify research opportunities and funding resources. To promote the research acumen of faculty and students, the Research Cell of our institution published two research Journals – Carmel Blaze and Carmel Bloom respectively. Curie Project for women colleges sponsored by DST, with a funding of around 53 lakhs, enabled us to march towards research excellence.

Constructive change and improvement in spheres of academic engagement are a mandate of our times. To fulfil the need and to ascertain credulity in the transaction of knowledge and competency, our institution incorporates learner-centric, technology-integrated pedagogy and inclusive learning strategies. The institution has a fully-automated library, state of art labs, well-equipped seminar/conference halls, and requisite physical amenities to support the curricular,



extra-curricular and non-curricular requirements of students. The college annually organizes a series of student-centric programmes that cater to honing their cognitive, experiential, innovative, creative and artistic flair. This year 21 certificate courses and 9 skill development courses offered by various departments as part of the student's skill enrichment initiative of the IQAC of the college have been set to gear.

Additionally, discipline-centric seminars, and webinars of regional, national and international levels on diverse areas including research ethics, gender concerns, sociology, climate change, environment/biodiversity conservation, science and technology, energy conservation, human rights and dignity, research integrity and publication ethics, literature and language, E-commerce, business and financial management, GST, Career scopes in particular disciplines, health and hygiene, and agripreneurship were held. Skill-upgradation workshops, field visits, industrial visits, media visits, study trips, expert coaching for competitive examinations and faculty-student exchange also form the crux of educative undertakings by each department to ensure industry knowledge and experience to students. Proactive engagement in MHRD sponsored programmes like UBA, Ek Bharat Sreshta Bharat, Institution Innovation Council, NISP and Young Innovators Programme by K-DISC, ASAP of Kerala Govt. have been undertaken by the institution to garner extensive exposure.

Empowering our students with the requisite industry skills of the time is of utmost importance and to attain the same, the institution, under the aegis of various departments, cells and clubs has organized career guidance programmes, entrepreneurship workshops, skill/capacity building programmes and exhibition cum product sales. The Career Guidance and Placement Cell has been organizing programmes on the campus to equip students with the necessary knowledge, skills and values to make informed decisions to manage their career pathways or to go for higher studies. The cell in collaboration with external resources like Avodha Edutech Pvt. Ltd, Bengaluru, Manappuram Foundation, HDFC, Employment Information and Guidance Bureau, Kerala Agricultural University, Government of Kerala, National Employment Service, Mahindra Pride Classroom and Naandi Foundation have organized career orientation training sessions and workshops for students. HDFC Life Smart Achievers Program and HDFC Life Campus Recruitment Drive are also organized under the aegis of the cell.

As the primary stakeholders of our institution, our students have been rightfully accorded with autonomy and agency to excel in their leadership skills and teamwork. Following the College union election on 8th November 2022, the inauguration of the duly elected student body was conducted on November 15th by Dr.B.Manoj kumar, Registrar, Kerala University of Fisheries and Ocean Studies. The Fine Arts Club was inaugurated by Cine artists Priya Varrier and Sarjano Khalid and the college magazine 'Ezperanza' on the theme of empowered women was officially released by Dr. Robin Radhakrishnan. Perceptively guided by expert faculty, the student union, Fine arts committee and Magazine committee have endeavoured in all earnestness to bring alive the vibe of campus life by hosting cultural-literary events, fests, the celebration of festivities, commemoration of important days, collaborations, release of the college magazine and other community-centric service activities. The college union in collaboration with NCC took initiative in commencing the Election literacy club and arranged provision for linking of Election card and adhar card for those in need. The Fine Arts Fest tested the literary and artistic flair and team spirit of the students while the committee also collaborated with Akashvani, Thrissur to present a radio show - Young Radio Scouting event "AIRNxt" in connection with Aazadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav based on the theme " Make in India- Skill India Opportunities to the next Generation". The Women's cell in collaboration with KANAL ,ICDS and Taluk legal services society conducted programmes for the students of the institution.



Sports and games are a pivotal forte of Carmel College. This academic year saw commendable feats by our sports students, uplifting the name of the college. True to its motto "Health is Wealth", this academic year saw new significant undertakings by the department of Physical education in addition to providing professional coaching in Archery, Ball Badminton, cycling Football, Karate, Taekwondo, Sepak takraw, Throw ball and Cricket. From introducing 7 Short term /Diploma courses in Physical Fitness and Basics of different foreign languages, the department hosted the Calicut university Ball Badminton(W) Team camp, conducted training sessions in Yoga, Zumba, Relaxation Therapy, Taekwondo, Karate and Self Defense, commemorated International Yoga Day through a one-week mass yoga awareness training programme and successfully conducted the annual Sports inter-Departmental tournaments in the campus.

Carmel College Ball Badminton team became overall Champions in Calicut University for the 6th time continuously and champions in Kerala State Ball Badminton Senior Tournament. Joshna John V was awarded "Star of India" in All India Senior Ball Badminton Tournament in the year 2022-23.

Apart from these our students have secured altogether 21 gold, Silver and Bronze medals in various tournaments of different sports events. Our students are selected to national and state level teams and represented famous sports clubs and leagues.

With the mission of enhancing the community, the institution in tie-up with GOs/NGOs, hospitals/schools and neighbourhood units undertook several extension /Outreach programmes. Student-led units such as NSS, NCC, AICUF, and department associations earnestly involved in Clean India Campaign in association with Swatchh Bharat Abhiyan, Anti Narcotics campaigns, Health awareness programmes like 'We Care Project' by Kerala Government, AIDS awareness programmes and the like. In connection with Punit Sagar Abhiyan, our students actively participated in the cleaning programme at Munakkal beach, conducted socio political surveys at adopted villages, Environment Conservation campaigns, and distributed food packets to the needy ones. To extend our hearts and hands towards the neediest through acts of compassion and companionship, each department undertook social linkage programme to the nearby old age homes, care centres and special schools.

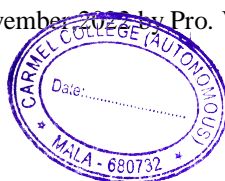
A new college bus was sanctioned from MP Fund by Benny Behanan, Honorable MP of Chalakudy in order to reduce the travelling difficulties of the college.

IQAC

The activities of IQAC began at the start of the new academic year since the college was all set to welcome the NAAC Peer Team in the first week itself. Keeping that in mind an Orientation session for all the teaching and non-teaching staff was conducted by the IQAC with Dr. Ajims P.Mohammed, Principal, MES Marampally as resource person on 2/6/22 in the Audio-visual room. A live interactive webinar on 'Career opportunities after Graduation', was organized for the final year students with resource person from Unacademy on 6/7/22. An Impact lecture series on 'Entrepreneurship' was initiated by the IQAC along with IIC and the Department of Botany sponsored by the MIC-MHRD on 9/7/22. On 13/7/22, Malayala Manorama in association with the IQAC, Carmel College (Autonomous), gave away study material as part of scholarship to three students of the department of Political Science and two students from Sociology for the year 2022-23. Collaborative programmes such as workshops on e-certificate generation with the Department of Software Development were organized on 13/7/22 and 15/7/22 for teachers and students respectively through the online mode. As part of its quality enhancement initiatives, the IQAC in collaboration with the college library, an Orientation session on Administration and Examination process in Autonomous colleges was conducted on 27/7/22 with Dr. Joy.l.Retd.Principal, St.Thomas College (Autonomous).

An awareness session on Intellectual Property Rights was organized on 27/8/22 through online mode. Dr. Joyce Jose was the resource person. An Orientation session on Blooms' Taxonomy was organized on 12/9/22, which was followed by a workshop on Qn Smarti. Dr. Mendus Jacob, Dr. Sunil Job and Mr. Nibin Sunny were the guest speakers respectively. Under an MoU signed with St. Paul Institute of Advanced studies, Indore, a National webinar was organized on 13/9/22. In its bid to encourage research activities, along with the Research Cell, a seminar on Data analysis and Reporting was conducted on 26/9/22. A session on Career opportunities for graduate students in and outside India was handled by an internationally certified coach of Easylink academy. A training programme was also conducted to acquaint teachers with distribution and CO mapping on 18/10/22. A state seminar for the Non-Teaching staff was conducted on 24/2/23 in the Audio-visual room with Dr. Mohammed Saleem and Ms. Gilu as resource persons. The academic audit for the year 2022-23 was conducted by the IQAC on 21/3/23, 22/3/23 and 24/3/23 for the science, arts/commerce and B.Voc streams respectively. Besides this, in an attempt to expand collaborative activities, under the leadership of the IQAC, more than 17 MoUs were signed this year and various activities were carried out by the departments.

RESEARCH CELL

Research cell organised a seminar for students on the topic "Project Orientation; Stage -I -Problem formation, Review of Literature and Questionnaire design and Stage 2: Data Analysis and Reporting" on 26th September 2022 from 9.30 a.m to 3.30 p.m. The resource Person was Dr. Vineeth K.M, Assistant Professor and Research Supervisor, PG Dept. of Commerce Govt. College Thripunithara. In the forenoon session the resource person explained why literature reviews are important as research tools, especially in emerging areas, with populations that typically yield small samples, or in areas that represent value-laden positions adopted by advocacy groups. He said that literature reviews are valuable in light of the knowledge explosion and the consequent impossibility of reading everything. The afternoon session was hands-on training on Data Analysis and Reporting using the software SPSS. The overall session was very interesting and informative for students doing their project.

Multidisciplinary journal- Carmel Blaze -July 2022 issue and Carmel Bloom-November 2022 issue were published. Articles are invited from faculties for the publication in the upcoming issue of Carmel Blaze -July 2023.



Financial assistance by the Management of Carmel College (Autonomous), Mala for publication in Scopus or Web of Science indexed journals and paper presentation in national or international conferences for the year 2022-23 were given to faculties on submission of the relevant documents.

A seminar on “Advanced Academic Web Search Strategies” was conducted for the faculties on 15th March 2023. The resource person was Mr.Jasimudeen, Librarian, St.Stephens College, Uzhavoor, Kottayam. The purpose of the seminar was to examine the use of various search engines and meta search engines by Indian academics for retrieving information on the web. It also aims to know whether the faculties use search strategy of various search engines for retrieval of information or not, and how the faculties learn the various search strategies for using search engines. The seminar equipped our teachers on, how to competently source, online information, for retrieving the relevant information.

LIBRARY

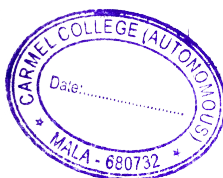

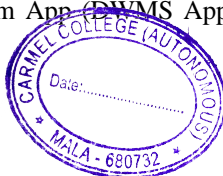
FINE ARTS

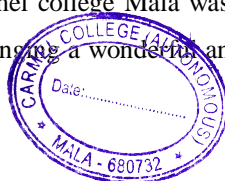
NCC

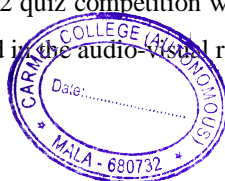

DEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITIES 2022-2023

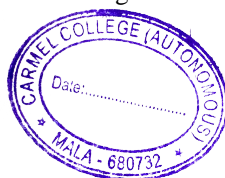
The departmental activities made the campus vigorous and vibrant throughout the year. Let's have a quick glance the relevant programmes of the various departments.

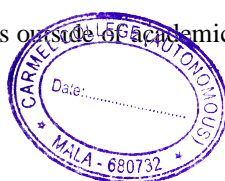
DEPARTMENT OF VOCATIONAL STUDIES

ACCOUNTING AND TAXATION

The seedlings of Common Globe Amaranth (*Gomphrena globosa*), Marigold (*Tagetes spp.*), Indian Borage (*Coleus aromaticus*), and Common Purslane (*Portulaca oleraceae*) were kept for sale in front of the canteen.

Seminars were organised by subject experts to teach the principles and innovative strategies that are employed to sustain agricultural production. Agripreneurship is the entrepreneurial process taken up in agriculture or the allied sectors. 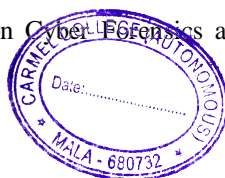

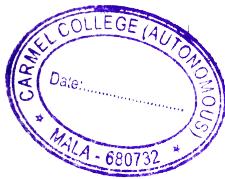
